Designed for professionals in insurance, healthcare, claims adjustment, and corporate compliance, this 9-course program explores contracts, torts, insurance law, medical records analysis, litigation procedures, and regulatory compliance. Graduates will be prepared to navigate legal challenges, reduce liability, and work effectively within organizations managing legal risk in complex operational environments. **Courses may be substituted or changed at any time, as curriculums undergo continued revision and updating.**

## **Legal Foundations for Business and Insurance**

Overview of legal systems, sources of law, and legal reasoning with emphasis on business and insurance applications. 4 Credits.

## **Contracts and Commercial Transactions**

Explores contract formation, enforceability, breach, and remedies with focus on sales, service agreements, and licensing. 4 Credits.

## **Torts, Liability, and Personal Injury Law**

Covers negligence, strict liability, product liability, and personal injury litigation as they relate to insurance and claims. 4 Credits.

## **Auto And Homeowners Insurance Law and Regulation**

Detailed examination of auto insurance policies, coverage disputes, subrogation, no-fault laws, and state regulations. 4 Credits.

## **Claims Investigation and Dispute Resolution**

Best practices in managing insurance claims, including evidence gathering, settlement negotiations, and arbitration strategies. Students complete a comprehensive case study or simulated project involving the legal analysis of a business, insurance, or medical claim. 4 Credits.

## **Medical Records and Legal Documentation**

Interpreting medical records, understanding treatment codes, and evaluating causation in injury and disability claims. 4 Credits.

## **Healthcare Law and Patient Rights**

Covers HIPAA, informed consent, malpractice, and legal responsibilities of healthcare providers and institutions. 4 Credits.

## **Business Organizations and Corporate Compliance**

Legal structures of businesses, corporate governance, regulatory compliance, and risk management in operational settings. 4 Credits.

## **Employment Law and Workplace Injury**

Explores employee rights, workers' compensation law, ADA, FMLA, and managing workplace legal issues. 4 Credits.
